

Campsite Rules – Accommodation

We are delighted that you have chosen Camping Coogherveld!

Before you come to Texel, we kindly ask you to read the following rules carefully. This way, you will know in advance what is expected of you and what you can expect from us during your stay. Do you have any questions about one of the rules? Please feel free to contact us – we are happy to help.

Number of guests

You have rented a holiday accommodation suitable for a maximum of 4 or 5 people, depending on the type of accommodation. It is not permitted to stay in the accommodation with more people than the maximum number for which the accommodation is intended.

Have you forgotten to register someone, or is an additional person joining you during your stay? Please report this to reception. The applicable campsite fees also apply to babies and overnight guests.

Waste

At Camping Coogherveld, waste is collected separately. At the entrance to the campsite, you will find containers for:

- general waste;
- glass;
- paper and cardboard;
- plastic waste;
- metal.

Please dispose of your waste in the correct container and do not leave any waste or rubbish bags next to the containers. Deposit bottles can be donated to charity using the designated container.

Cars and traffic

A maximum speed of 10 km/h applies throughout the campsite. Please be aware of children playing and other guests. One-way traffic applies on the campsite.

- Parking is only permitted in the designated parking areas.
- Between 23:00 and 07:30, car traffic is not permitted on the campsite.
- It is not permitted to charge your car at your accommodation.
- An electric car charging station is available at the second entrance to the campsite.

BBQs and fire

BBQs are permitted. A low BBQ may not be placed directly on the grass. Do you need a paving stone for this? You can borrow one from reception. Open fires, such as fire baskets or campfires, are not permitted on the campsite.

Visitors

Visitors are very welcome. We ask you to register your visitors at reception in advance or upon arrival.

For day visitors, the following applies:

- Visitors' cars are not allowed to drive onto or park on the campsite.
- Visitors staying overnight must be registered (see "Number of guests").
- The applicable campsite fees will be charged for overnight visitors.

Bicycles

Please do not place bicycles directly against your accommodation. Use the designated bicycle parking area or position the bicycles in a way that prevents damage to the accommodation.

Gas bottles

If your accommodation is not connected to the natural gas network, two gas bottles are provided at your chalet or lodge.

If one gas bottle is empty, you can connect and use the other one.

Please let us know at reception when a gas bottle is empty. Do you need help changing the gas bottle? Feel free to come and see us at reception.

Dogs

A maximum of 2 dogs are welcome in selected chalets. This must have been indicated at the time of booking. Dogs must always be kept on a lead throughout the campsite and must be walked outside the campsite. If your dog stays in the accommodation, we ask you to:

- use your own dog basket, blanket or crate;
- not allow your dog on the sofa, beds, cushions or duvets;
- vacuum the accommodation thoroughly before departure.

This helps us keep the accommodation pleasant and clean for the next guests.

Inventory

The furniture and inventory in the accommodation are intended for indoor use. Garden furniture is provided for outdoor use. Please therefore do not use the indoor furniture or inventory outdoors.

Seagulls

Please do not feed the seagulls. Feeding seagulls causes nuisance and can result in dirt and damage to, among other things, your car.

Quiet hours

To ensure that everyone can enjoy their stay, we ask you to be considerate of your surroundings between 22:00 and 08:00 and to keep noise to a minimum.

Emergency

In the event of a malfunction or emergency, you can contact us via the intercom at the reception door.

In case of a medical emergency, call **112**. An AED is available at reception.

Maintenance

Our staff must always be able to carry out necessary repairs and maintenance work on the accommodation and the campsite grounds. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Attaching and Fixing Materials

It is not permitted to attach or fix mosquito nets, blackout materials, adhesive hooks, tape or other materials to window frames, doors or furniture. This may cause damage or leave adhesive residue.

Mail and parcels

There is a mailbox outside reception where you can post your mail. Incoming mail can be found in the mailboxes outside reception. Parcels can be collected during reception opening hours.

Reception

The current opening hours of reception can be found on the reception door and in our WebApp.

Smoking and drugs

Smoking is not permitted in:

- the reception;
- the sanitary facilities;
- the playground and covered area;
- our rental accommodations.

The use of drugs is not tolerated anywhere on the campsite.

Damage and malfunctions

Have you caused any damage or noticed damage to the accommodation or inventory? Please report this to reception as soon as possible. This allows us to inspect the damage in good time and take action where necessary.

Barrier gate

The barrier gate is open from 07:30 to 23:00. After 23:00, driving across the campsite by car is not permitted. Please also take this into account on your departure day.

Tent

It is not permitted to put up an additional tent next to a chalet or lodge. A party tent may be no larger than 2.5 x 2.5 metres.

Toilet

To prevent blockages, nappies, sanitary towels, tampons and food waste must not be flushed down the toilet.

Laundry

Tokens for the washing machines and dryers can be purchased during reception opening hours. The required laundry detergent is included in the price of the laundry token.
