

Campsite Rules

We are delighted that you have chosen Camping Coogherveld!

Before you come to Texel, we kindly ask you to read the following rules carefully. This way, you will know in advance what is expected of you and what you can expect from us during your stay. Do you have any questions about one of the rules or are you unsure about something? Please feel free to contact us – we are happy to help.

Number of guests

A maximum of 6 people are allowed per pitch. Have you forgotten to register someone, or is an additional person joining you during your stay? Please report this to reception. This also applies to babies, overnight guests and dogs; the applicable campsite fees will be charged.

Waste

At Camping Coogherveld, waste is collected separately. At the entrance to the campsite, you will find containers for:

- general waste;
- glass;
- paper and cardboard;
- plastic waste;
- metal.

Please dispose of your waste in the correct container and do not leave any waste or rubbish bags next to the containers. Deposit bottles can be donated to charity using the designated container.

Cars and traffic

A maximum speed of 10 km/h applies throughout the campsite. Please be aware of children playing and other guests. One-way traffic applies on the campsite.

- There is space for one car per pitch.
- Between 23:00 and 07:30, car traffic is not permitted on the campsite.
- It is not permitted to charge your car on your pitch.
- An electric car charging station is available at the second entrance to the campsite.

BBQs and fire

BBQs are permitted. A low BBQ may not be placed directly on the grass. Do you need a paving stone for this? You can borrow one from reception. Open fires, such as fire baskets or campfires, are not permitted on the campsite.

Visitors

Visitors are very welcome. We ask you to register your visitors at reception in advance or upon arrival.

For day visitors, the following applies:

- Visitors' cars are not allowed to drive onto or park on the campsite;
- Visitors staying overnight must be registered (see "Number of guests");
- The applicable campsite fees will be charged for overnight visitors.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at Camping Coogherveld. The following rules apply:

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times throughout the campsite.
- Dogs may not be walked on the campsite grounds.
- The grass area near the wooden posts and information sign at the front of the reception is also not a designated dog-walking area.
- A maximum of 2 dogs are allowed per pitch.

Setting up your pitch

There are a few rules regarding the setup of your pitch. These rules are intended to keep the grass and pitches looking neat and green.

- Under or next to your awning or tent annex, only water- and air-permeable fabric is permitted.
- Waterproof ground sheets, plastic sheets and solid flooring are not permitted.
- No additional ground sheet, outdoor carpet or other impermeable ground covering may be placed in front of the awning.
- An additional canopy attached to the awning is permitted, provided it has no side walls and no outdoor carpet or other impermeable ground covering.
- The total setup of your camping vehicle, awning and any additional canopy may not exceed 1.5 times the surface area of the camping vehicle.

One camping vehicle of up to 8 metres in length and one additional tent of up to 3 m² may be placed on each pitch. A party tent may be no larger than 2.5 x 2.5 metres.

Seagulls

Please do not feed the seagulls. Feeding seagulls causes nuisance and can result in dirt and damage to your motorhome, caravan, tent and/or car.

Quiet hours

To ensure that everyone can enjoy their stay, we ask you to be considerate of your surroundings between 22:00 and 08:00 and to keep noise to a minimum.

Emergency

In the event of a malfunction or emergency, you can contact us via the intercom at the reception door.

In case of a medical emergency, call **112**. An AED is available at reception.

Maintenance

Our staff must always be able to carry out necessary repairs and maintenance work on the campsite.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Mail and parcels

There is a mailbox outside reception where you can post your mail. Incoming mail can be found in the mailboxes outside reception. Parcels can be collected during reception opening hours.

Reception

The current opening hours of reception can be found on the reception door and in our WebApp.

Smoking and drugs

Smoking is not permitted in:

- the reception
- the sanitary facilities
- the playground and covered area
- our rental accommodations

The use of drugs is not tolerated anywhere on the campsite.

Damage and malfunctions

Have you caused any damage or noticed a malfunction? Please report this to reception as soon as possible. This allows us to inspect the damage in good time and take action where necessary.

Barrier gate

The barrier gate is open from 07:30 to 23:00. After 23:00, driving across the campsite by car is not permitted. Please also take this into account on your departure day.

Toilet

To prevent blockages, nappies, sanitary towels, tampons and food waste must not be flushed down the toilet.

Laundry

Tokens for the washing machines and dryers can be purchased during reception opening hours. Laundry detergent is included in the price of the laundry token.
